



Overseas Summer Study Programmes 2018

1. Enrollment Method

- 1.1 Students should do the online registration for the programmes that they intend to enroll through the websites of the respective programmes and arrange necessary payment (such as tuition fees and accommodation fees) themselves according to the instructions of the programmes. For enquiries, students should directly contact the host universities.
- 1.2 For those students who will enroll in the programmes recommended by the Department of Linguistics and Modern Languages, they should complete the registration form downloaded from the website of the Department of Linguistics and Modern Languages (<http://www.cuhk.edu.hk/lin>) (under “News and Events” and to be available during **1-31 March 2018**) and return the form together with a copy of transcripts downloaded from CUSIS to the Department’s General Office (Room G17, G/F., Leung Kau Kui Building, CUHK) by **31 March 2018** for record and application for financial support (if available).

2. Financial Support

- 2.1 All students who have submitted the registration form together with their academic reports mentioned in item no. 1.2 will automatically be considered for the financial support (if available):
 - The Department of Linguistics and Modern Languages will offer 5 awards of HK\$5,000 each to 5 non-final year Linguistics Major students (with cumulative GPA of at least 3.0).
 - Students can also apply for the “Summer Subsistence and Travel Loan Scheme” (<https://www.oafa.cuhk.edu.hk/sfas/open-for-application/financial-aid>). The application deadline is 16 March 2018.
 - Besides, funding support from the different consulates may also be available.
- 2.2 Students are encouraged to visit the Colleges’ websites or contact the College Offices for financial support for taking overseas summer study programmes. Please be reminded to pay attention to the application deadlines. In the past, Chung Chi College, New Asia College, Shaw College and United College offered different grants and loans to their students to participate in overseas study programmes.
- 2.3 While different funding parties may have different selection criteria, for those awards administered by the Department of Linguistics and Modern Languages, the following criteria are adopted:
 - (1) No. of Modern Language courses taken
 - (2) Cumulative GPA of Modern Languages courses
 - (3) Overall cumulative GPA
- 2.4 The results of the financial awards will be announced via email and all the awards will be given to the recipients after their study trips. Recipients are required to inform the Department of Linguistics and Modern Language if they receive any other funding support for their trips from/or through other units of the CUHK and the Department has the right for not granting the awards or reducing the amount of the awards to the recipients.
- 2.5 Upon completion of the programmes, recipients of financial awards are required to submit copies of their certificate of attendance and/or academic reports together with the **original** copies of the payment receipts of air tickets, tuition fees and accommodation fees in order to receive the awards. Moreover, the recipients are also required to submit a CD with a written report about the overseas learning experience of **500-800** words in English together with **10** digital photographs of the study trips. The granters and the Department of Linguistics and Modern Languages shall have the right to publish and use the whole or part of the report and photographs.
