Course Fees: 920 euros in July/870 euros in August

No registration fee. This price includes the course + textbook and workbook + cultural outing once a week + personal follow-up.

Advance Fees (not refundable): About half of the total fee (refer to website) (the 1st part of course fee to pay to the CLA).

<u>Amount to pay in Besançon</u>: The remaining part of the total fee (rest of the course fees (also payable in advance by bank wire)) + accommodation fee (also payable in advance by bank wire).

Accommodation Fees: Individual Room in a student university residence in town: about 390 euros per month, (internet connection and breakfast on weekdays included) or host in a French family (in July only) in the centre of town about 30 euros per day. Confirmation of your registration at the CLA of Besançon doesn't automatically provides you with accommodation. Any housing request should be done while enrolling in one of our training courses featuring in the online catalogue. Fill in the "Accommodation Request" (demande d'hébergement) form at the end of the registration process. You will then be emailed as soon as possible the contact details of a housing you should get in touch with in order to confirm your booking. Depending on the length of your stay and on the type of housing comfort you're looking for, there are several options for you to choose from: host families, Student accommodation, self-contained accommodation, Hotels and International hostels. Feel free to ask the CLA's accommodation service for advice and arrangement for your bookings. ENROLMENT AND PAYMENT. Procedure:

- 1. International service "Paybox" online on the site of the CLA, after having created your own account online on the site. This service allows only to pay the full course fee (950 euros) at once.

B. Enrolment with the Linguistics & Modern Languages Department (compulsory)

Besançon and its area: Besançon is the capital of the department of Doubs and of the Franche-Comté region in eastern France, close to the border with Switzerland. In 2012, it had a population of 116,353. Once proclaimed first green city of France, it has been labeled a "Town of Art and History" since 1986. Since 2008, Besançon's Vauban citadel has been listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The city has one of the most beautiful historic centers of any major town in France. A broad horse-shoe of the river Doubs, "la Boucle", encircles the old town, while Vauban's imposing Citadelle blocks off the neck. The historic center presents a remarkable ensemble of classic stone buildings, some dating back to the Middle Ages and others to the Spanish Renaissance. Her festivals and events throughout the year lend vibrancy to the air. There is her fabulous history of watchmaking and micro- and nanotechnologies that connects the halls of time and science.

MANDATORY PROCEDURE FOR ALL PARTICIPANTS

To be eligible for a **SCHOLARSHIP**, you must follow this procedure:

- You must first enroll at the General Office (Leung Kau Kui Blg) between March 1st and March 31st. Application forms can be downloaded from the website of the Department of Linguistics and Modern Languages (http://www.cuhk.edu.hk/lin under "Events and News"/"Modern Languages Events"). Please return the completed form to the Department's General Office at G/F, Leung Kau Kui Building, during the application period. The department will proceed to a first selection, by the end of April.

In case of application for **Credit Transfer** you need to get (from your school in France) the necessary documents in **ENGLISH**:

- **Detailed** Course Outline (grammar and Vocabulary content)
- Diploma and/or Certificate (marks and grades **must** appear)
