<b>Language of Instruction: Korean &amp; English</b>	<b>Units: 1</b>

<b>Course Description</b>
<p>This online course invites students without prior knowledge of Korean to explore the basic features of the Korean language and topics of Korean culture and society. Supported by audiovisual aids, students will learn basic concepts of Korean grammar and vocabularies for simple daily communication. This course serves as a taster for students who may consider taking Korean courses in the future.</p>
