# FREN1001 Invitation to French



Language of Instruction: English Units: 1 2023-2024

#### **Course Description**

This course is for students without prior knowledge of French to discover some aspects of the French culture along with some basic elements of the French language. With the support of audio-visual materials, short textual information, different interactive tasks and online tests, it aims to help students get familiar with practical and cultural aspects of daily life in a French-speaking environment. It serves as a taster for students who might consider taking three-unit or six-unit French courses offered by the French programme of CUHK in the future.

#### Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of the course, students are expected to be able to:

- understand some basic features of the French language.
- interact in simple French in daily contexts, e.g., greetings, ordering food in a restaurant, expressing preferences for the food, etc.
- learn French independently as part of their learning experience.

Part C (page 3): choosing the correct reply/answer to a spoken sentence/ question (items 32 to 47).

#### Academic Honesty and Plagiarism

  - Students are fully aware that their work may be investigated by AI content detection software to determine originality.
  - Students are fully aware of the AI approach(es) adopted in the course. In the case where some AI tools are allowed, students have made proper acknowledgment and citations as suggested by the course teacher.
- Assignments without a properly signed declaration will not be graded by teachers.
- Only the final version of the assignment should be submitted via VeriGuide.
- The submission of a piece of work, or a part of a piece of work, for more than one purpose (e.g. to satisfy the requirements in two different courses) without declaration to this effect shall be regarded as having committed undeclared multiple submissions. It is common and acceptable to reuse a turn of phrase or a sentence or two from one's own work; but wholesale reuse is problematic. In any case, agreement from the course teacher(s) concerned should be obtained prior to the submission of the piece of work.
- The copyright of the teaching materials, including lecture notes, assignments and examination questions, etc., produced by staff members/ teachers of The Chinese University of Hong Kong (CUHK) belongs to CUHK. Students may download the teaching materials produced by the staff members/ teachers from the Learning Management Systems, e.g. Blackboard, adopted by CUHK for their own educational use, but shall not distribute/ share/ copy the materials to a third-party without seeking prior permission from the staff members/ teachers concerned.

#### Use of Generative Artificial Intelligence (AI) Tools in Teaching, Learning and Assessment

All use of AI tools is prohibited in assignments and assessment tasks.

- For assignments and assessment tasks that count towards the final course grades, students are not allowed to submit work which is produced with the collaboration of or supported by the use of any generative AI tools (e.g. ChatGPT).
- Any breach of the regulations will be considered an act of academic dishonesty and will be handled according to the University's *Procedures for Handling Cases of Academic Dishonesty*.
- In case of queries, students should seek advice from the course teacher.

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
