



Overseas Summer Study Programmes of Modern Languages 2023

1. Enrollment Method

- 1.1 The Department of Linguistics and Modern Languages will recommend students to enroll in a list of summer overseas study programmes of Modern Languages available in 2023. Please pay attention to the details to be provided by individual language programmes.
- 1.2 Students should complete the online registration for their intended overseas language programme(s) through the websites of the respective overseas institutes and process the necessary payment (e.g., tuition fees, accommodation fees, etc.) on their own according to the instructions of the individual programmes. For enquiries, students should directly contact the host universities.

2. Financial Support

- 2.1 Students who would like to apply for financial sponsorship for studying in the language programmes recommended by the Department of Linguistics and Modern Languages should submit the online registration form through the following website: <https://cloud.itsc.cuhk.edu.hk/webform/view.php?id=13662678> from **1 March 2023 to 31 March 2023**. The applicant's unofficial transcript downloadable from CUSIS will be required for the online registration. Students who have submitted the registration form together with their unofficial transcripts will automatically be considered for the financial support:
 - The Department of Linguistics and Modern Languages will offer 5 awards of HK\$5,000 each to 5 non-final year Linguistics Major students (with cumulative GPA of at least 3.0).

The following criteria are adopted for selecting the award-recipients:

- (1) Number/Units of Modern Language courses taken
 - (2) Cumulative GPA of the Modern Languages courses taken
 - (3) Overall cumulative GPA
- 2.2 The recipients of the financial awards will be notified via email and the financial sponsorship will be reimbursed to the award-recipients after their study trips. Recipients are required to report to the Department of Linguistics and Modern Languages if they receive any other funding support for their trips provided from or through other units of the CUHK (see points 2.4 - 2.6). The Department reserves the right to claw back the awards for redistribution to other needy students, or to re-consider the amount of the financial sponsorship to the recipients under such circumstances.
 - 2.3 Upon completion of the programmes, recipients of financial awards are required to submit copies of their certificate of attendance and/or academic reports of the summer programme(s) they joined, together with the **original** copies of the payment receipts of air tickets, tuition fees and accommodation fees for reimbursing the sponsorship. Moreover, the recipients are required to submit a written report of **500-800** words in English on their overseas learning experience, together with **10** digital photographs taken during the study trip. The granters of the awards and the Department of Linguistics and Modern Languages will have the right to publish and use the whole or part of the report and photographs submitted by the award-recipients for publications and production of promotional materials for our Department as well as its academic programmes.
 - 2.4 Funding support from the different consulates may also be available. Details will be announced separately in due course.
 - 2.5 Student may apply for "Summer Subsistence and Travel Loan Scheme" administered by Office of Admissions and Financial Aid (OFA) for their summer overseas studies. Details can be found in the following website: http://admission.cuhk.edu.hk/aid/summer_and_travel.html.

- 2.6 A number of colleges at CUHK offer different grants and loans for students to participate in summer overseas study programmes. Students are encouraged to visit the websites of their affiliated colleges or contact the college offices for the relevant financial support.
- 2.6 To avoid missing the valuable opportunities to make use of your summer to study overseas, please pay attention to the application deadlines of different financial sponsorship schemes.
