Overseas Summer Study Programmes of Modern Languages 2025

1. Enrollment Method

- 1.1. The Department of Linguistics and Modern Languages will encourage students to enroll in a selection of overseas summer study programmes for Modern Languages available in 2025. Please refer to the details provided by each individual language programme.
- 1.2. Students must register online for their chosen overseas summer study programmes through the respective institutes' websites and handle payments (e.g., tuition, accommodation) independently as instructed. For inquiries, contact the host universities directly.

2. Financial Support

2.1. Students who want to apply for financial sponsorship for overseas summer study programmes recommended by the Department of Linguistics and Modern Languages should submit the online registration form through this website from **1 to 31 March 2025**: https://cloud.itsc.cuhk.edu.hk/webform/view.php?id=13703934

The applicant's unofficial transcript from CUSIS is required. Those who submit the form and transcript will be considered for financial support administered by the department.

- Five awards of HK\$5,000 each are available for non-final year Linguistics Major students with a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0, funded by the Department of Linguistics and Modern Languages.
- Funding support from various consulates is also provided. Details will be confirmed and announced in due course.

Award recipients are selected based on:

- 1) Number of Modern Language courses taken
- 2) GPA of Modern Languages courses
- 3) Overall cumulative GPA
- 2.2. Recipients of financial awards will be notified via email, and sponsorship will be reimbursed after completing their study trips. They must report any other funding from CUHK units to the Department of Linguistics and Modern Languages (see points 2.4 2.5). The Department may reclaim the awards for redistribution or reconsider the sponsorship amount. Final year students are eligible for support only if their programme ends by 31 July 2025.

- 2.3. After completing the programmes, award recipients must submit their attendance certificate or academic report, along with <u>original</u> payment receipts for air tickets (if any), tuition, and accommodation fees for reimbursement. They must also provide a written report of **500-800** words in English about their overseas learning experience, along with **10** digital photos from the study trip. The Department of Linguistics and Modern Languages and the award granters may publish and use the reports and photos for promotional materials.
- 2.4. Students can apply for the "Summer Subsistence and Travel Loan Scheme" through the Office of Admissions and Financial Aid (OAFA) for their overseas summer studies. More information is available on the following website:
